### Swim Time!

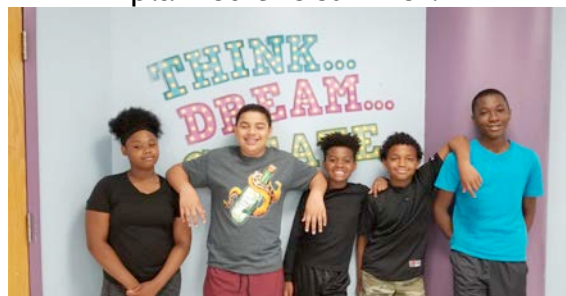
