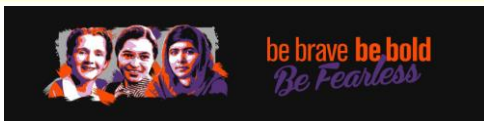

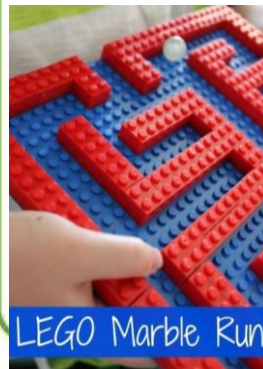
## LITERACY with Miss Jill


**Here's what each team needs:**
